"THE GLORY OF GOD"

God's greatest joy is in his Son Jesus Christ, providing complete authority, life, and knowledge of Himself to His people forever and ever.

John 17:1-5 September 6, 2020

1. <u>AUTHORITY</u> – (v.2a)

"You granted him authority over all people."

"Jesus came to them and said, "<u>All authority</u> in heaven and on earth has been given to me." – Matthew 28:18

"Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and **gave them authority** to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness." – Luke 9:1; Matthew 10:1

"The heavens declare the glory of God."- Psalm 19

2. LIFE - (v.2b-3)

"... that he might give <u>eternal life</u> to all those you have given him."

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth <u>and the life</u>. No one comes to the Father except through me." – John 14:6

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." – John 10:10

"I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols." – Isaiah 42:8

3. COMPLETE – (v.4-5)

"I have brought you glory on earth by <u>completing</u> the work you gave me to do."

"Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." – Philippians 1:6

"He is able to <u>save completely</u> those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them." – Hebrews 7:25
